**Graduate Program Prerequisites**

*Students applying for the Master of Applied Linguistics & Exegesis at ACTS Seminaries or the MA in Linguistics at TWU need to have completed the following courses either at CanIL or in their previous course work:*

<i>Sociolinguistics*</i>	<i>LING 210 Language &amp; Society</i>
<i>Articulatory Phonetics</i>	<i>LING 310 Articulatory Phonetics</i>
<i>Phonology</i>	<i>LING 330 Phonological Analysis</i>
<i>Morphology</i>	<i>LING 360 Grammatical Analysis</i>
<i>Syntax</i>	<i>LING 360 Grammatical Analysis</i>

*LING 360 is only offered in the summer. It is the equivalent of LING 361 Morphology (fall) + LING 362 Syntax (spring).*

*\*Language & Society is not required to enter the MA in Linguistics. However, for students interested in joining Wycliffe Bible Translators, this course is a training requirement and must be taken at an SIL school. It is also a prerequisite course for 2 graduate courses in the degree program.*

**Tuition Rate**

*The tuition rate for the 2012 summer session is \$245 per semester hour. Students may receive this rate if this summer session is their first semester at CanIL, TWU or ACTS. Students entering a degree program in a future semester are eligible for this reduced tuition rate for the summer but will pay the tuition rate of their degree program only when they begin full time studies.
